



***ITC*Transmission and METC Generator Interconnection Policy**

- *ITC*Transmission and METC obtained FERC approval to revise the cost allocation protocols for generation interconnections in 2007 in Dockets ER07-1141 and ER08-796, respectively.
- Attachment FF of the MISO Tariff was modified to authorize *ITC*Transmission and METC to reimburse interconnection generators 100% of interconnection costs if they met the requirements to be designated as a Network Resource or have a contractual agreement for one year or longer with a Network Customer. (See the tariff for the specific provisions.)
- Qualified Network Resource generators seeking to interconnect to the transmission system will initially pay upfront 100% of the transmission system network upgrade costs to either *ITC*Transmission or METC.
- Within 90 days of commercial operation of the generator, *ITC*Transmission or METC will reimburse the generator up to 100% of the money received for the network upgrades, including interest.
- Any radial facilities needed to connect the generation to the transmission system remain the cost responsibility of the generator.
